The GP- led COVID-19 vaccination clinic at Community House has now closed. It has been replaced by two new vaccination sites at The London Lane Clinic and St Edwards Church (Mottingham).

We would like to thank Community House for hosting a vaccination site for 12 weeks during the first phase of the vaccination programme.

What do you need to do?

If you received your first vaccination at Community House, **you will be contacted when you are due for your second dose**. An appointment will be offered at one of the new sites or at another GP led site if it is nearer to your GP practice.

Travel advice from Community House:

By Bus: From Bromley Town Hall take bus 208 or 320. (Stop: Warner Road). 5 min walk to the clinic.

By Car: Limited disabled only parking available on site. There is on-street parking available on London Lane, Kinnaird Avenue, Gilbert Road, and Warner Road (except between 12-2pm). All roads are a five-minute walk away from the clinic.

Travel advice from Community House:

By Bus: From Bromley Town Hall take bus 126 (Stop Dunkery Rd/Ravensworth Rd). The clinic is 5 min walk.

By Car: Access to the Church car park is for drop-off only; there is no parking available on site. There is free on street parking in neighbouring roads including Framlingham Crescent, Tenterden Close and Beaconsfield Road.
